

Individual Settlement Plans

Purpose

To support the family during the settling process enabling the family members to get a good start in Denmark.

How

- A comprehensive interview method identifies wishes, needs, demands and expectations of the employee and family.
- Living Institute project manager creates a settlement plan*
- 3-month follow-up by project manager adjusting plan and evaluating progress

When

During a pre-visit of the foreign employee or immediately after arrival in Denmark

What is in it for the foreign employee?

- Little time and energy spent sorting out personal interests, which surround an expatriate assignment.
- No worries about the well being of spouses and children
- Opportunity to focus on work assignments

* What does a Settlement Plan look like?

It is a family dialogue tool, which highlights

- The different expectations of family members
- Wishes, needs, worries - directions and solutions
- Guidance to locating specific primary products such as places of worship, specialized treatments, places to practice various hobbies, cultural events, charity organizations, places to go and things to see beyond mere tourism sights, etc.
